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# Paper Panache Spring Nosegay Pattern

## PAPER-PIECED FOUNDATION PATTERN

Each block 4.5"x4.5" including seam allowances

### 1. PRINT ONLY PAGE 2 PATTERNS FOR THE DRAWING.

This is a two-block quilt pattern. Minimum entry is 4 blocks, which is equal to 2 As and 2Bs. **Always make equal numbers of As and Bs:**

TO SUBMIT	SEND
4 blocks =	2 As and 2 Bs —print pg.2 x 2
8 blocks =	4 As and 4 Bs —print pg.2 x 4
12 blocks =	6 As and 6 Bs —print pg.2 x 6
16 blocks =	8 As and 8 Bs —print pg.2 x 8

The Optional Connector Patterns on pages 3-7 are for your personal use only. Do not make connectors for the drawing.

### 2. CHECK PATTERN SIZE:

Check the inch mark before you start to sew. PDFs really help ensure that everyone gets the same size pattern, but this is not a guarantee. You may need to photocopy a printout to the exact size—blocks must be 4.5"x4.5" with seam allowances.

### 3. COLORS:

**scr—scrap...**Please use PASTEL OR MEDIUM SHADES of pinks, peaches, and yellows, with the occasional light blue or purple. Mix up the size of your prints. **DO NOT USE DARKS OR GREENS** in the **scr** area of the block.

**gn—green...**Use medium to dark-medium green for the cones.

**wh—white...**Use light beige, muslin prints and white-on-white prints. Use the same **wh** fabric in all three spaces on each block (that is, do not use a variety of scrap whites in a block).

### 4. SEWING TIPS:

Print out enough page 2s to make the number of blocks you need.

If needed, you can find online paper piecing instructions at <http://www.paperpanache.com/howto/how.htm>. It outlines the steps for general paper piecing and also include tips for faster, easier sewing. As you sew, use a pin to hold down the previous piece until the next piece is added.

Make sure to leave enough fabric to cover the seam allowances.

Trim blocks on the outside line, keeping seam allowance.

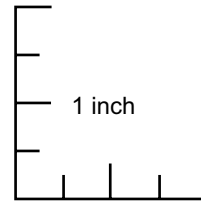
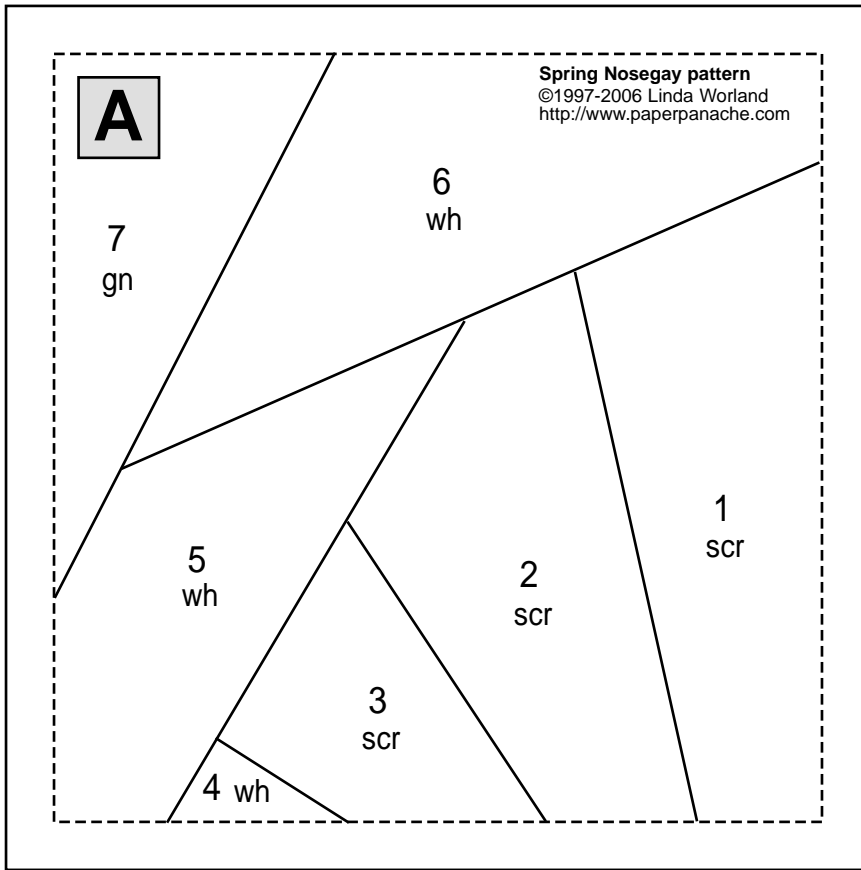
Do not sew them together. Do not remove the paper.

### 5. SIGN AND SUBMIT:

Write your name and city/state on the back of each block.

Each block 4.5"x4.5"  
including seam allowances

### COLORS:

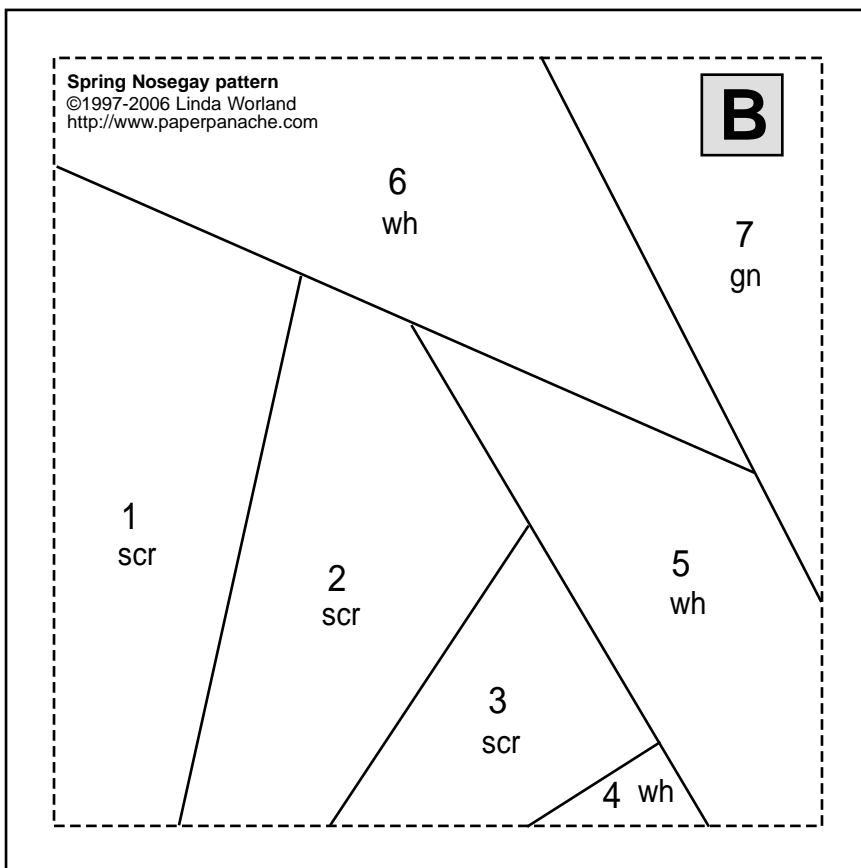
**scr—scrap...**Please use **PASTEL OR MEDIUM SHADES** of pinks, peaches, and yellows, with the occasional light blue or purple. Mix up the size of your prints. **DO NOT USE DARKS OR GREENS** in the scr area of the block.

**gn—green...**Use medium to dark medium green for the cones.

**wh—white...**Use light beige, muslin prints and white-on-white prints. Use the same wh fabric in all three spaces on each block (that is, do not use a variety of scrap whites in a block).

Print this page...

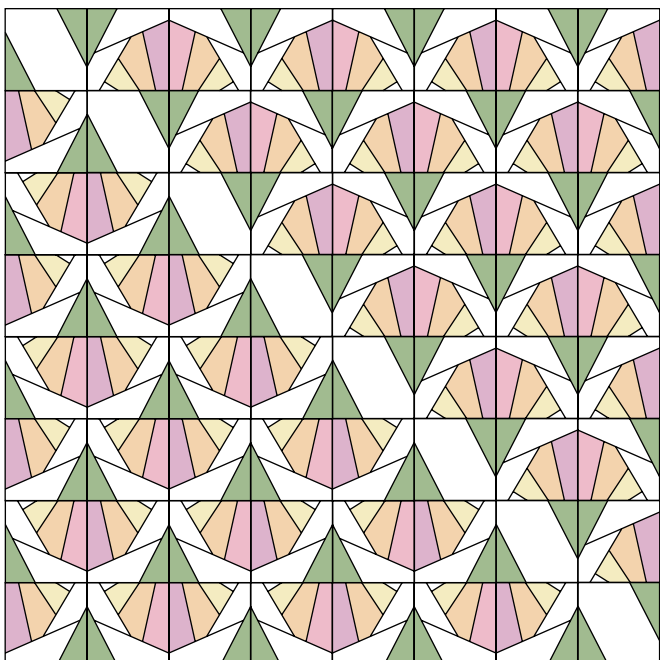
- 4 blocks = 2 As and 2 Bs —print x2
- 8 blocks = 4 As and 4 Bs —print x4
- 12 blocks = 6 As and 6 Bs —print x6
- 16 blocks = 8 As and 8 Bs —print x8



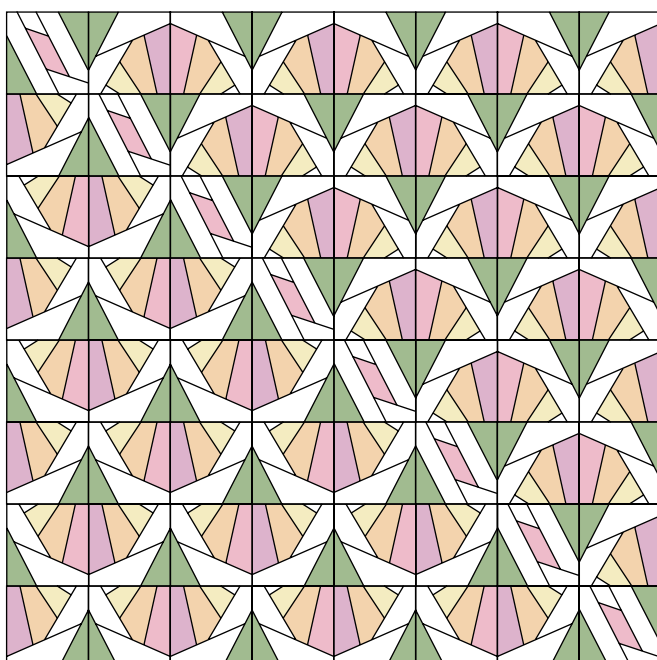

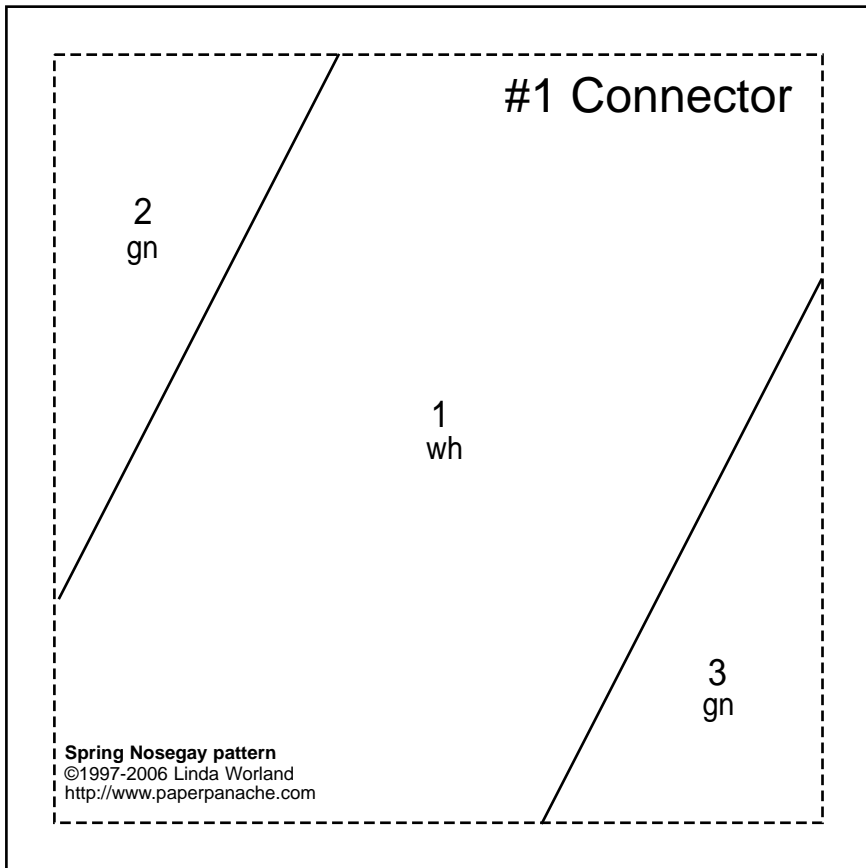


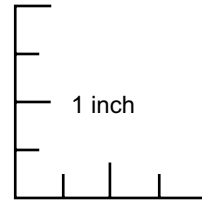
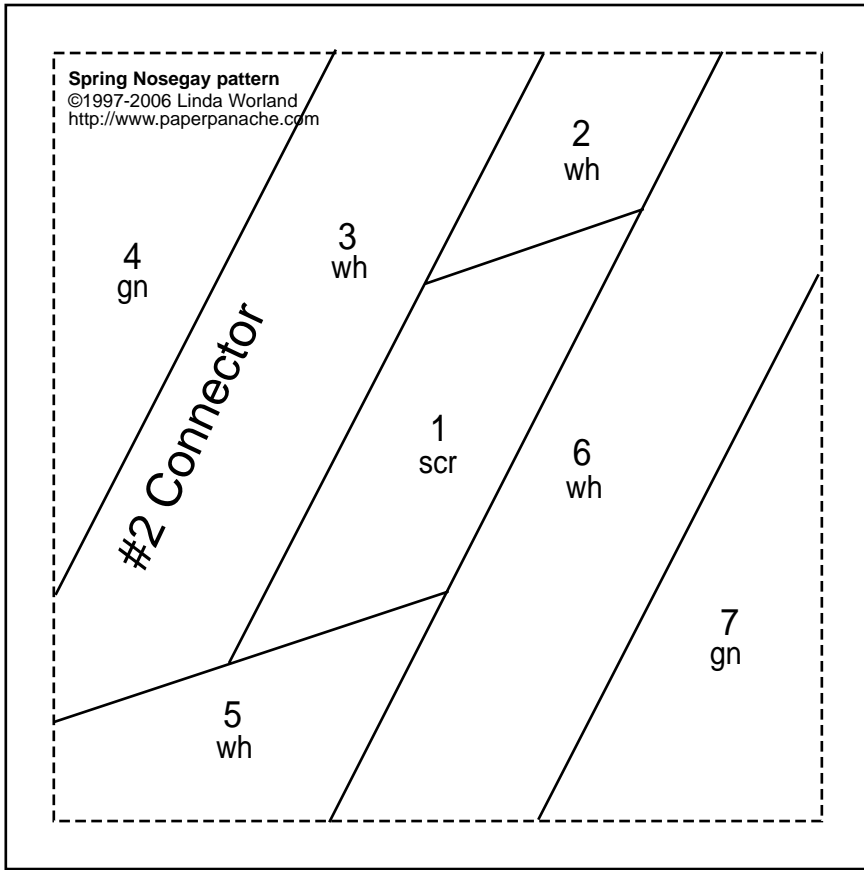


## Connector Pattern #1

This block is not part of the drawing. (Make only A & B blocks for drawing, please.)

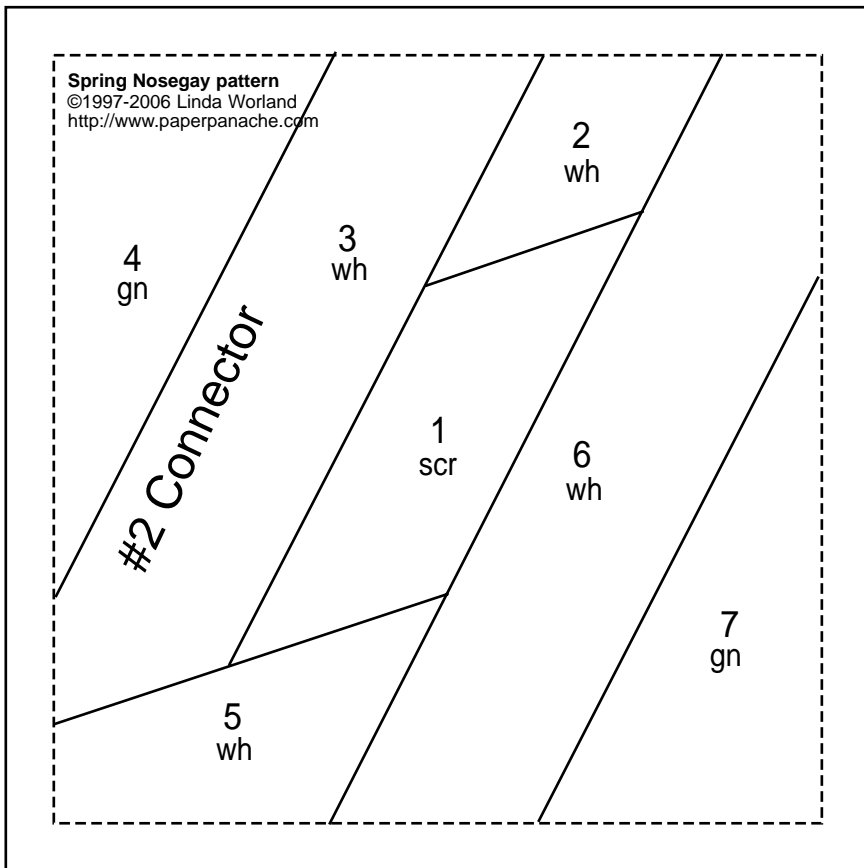


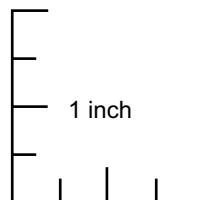
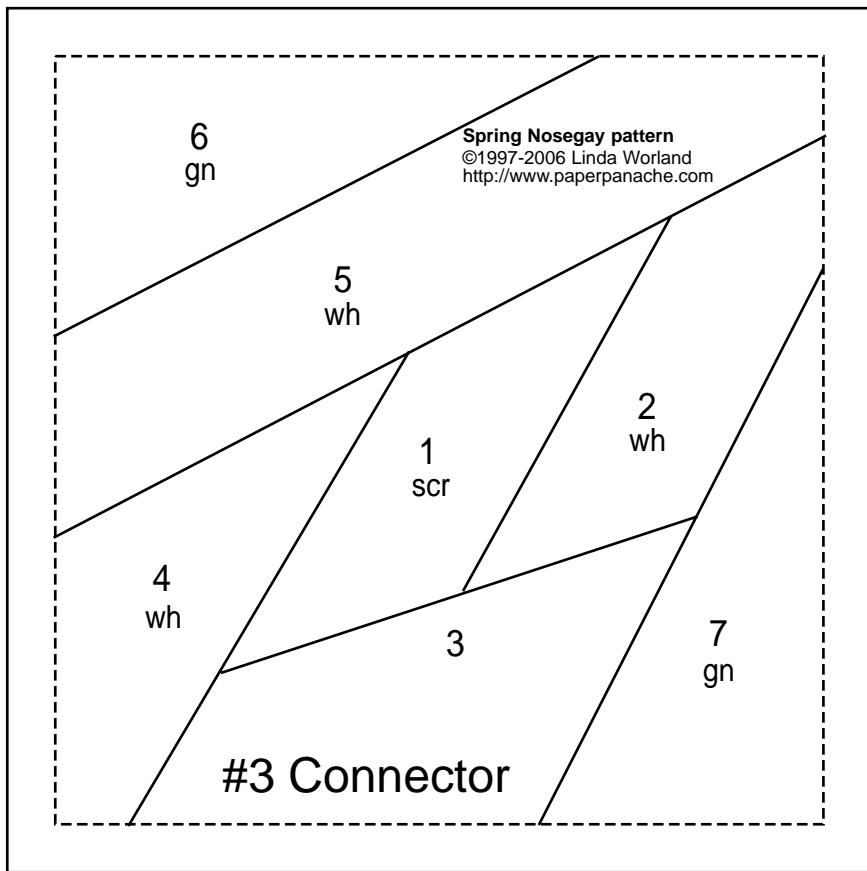


## Connector Pattern #2

This block is not part of the drawing. (Make only A & B blocks for drawing, please.)



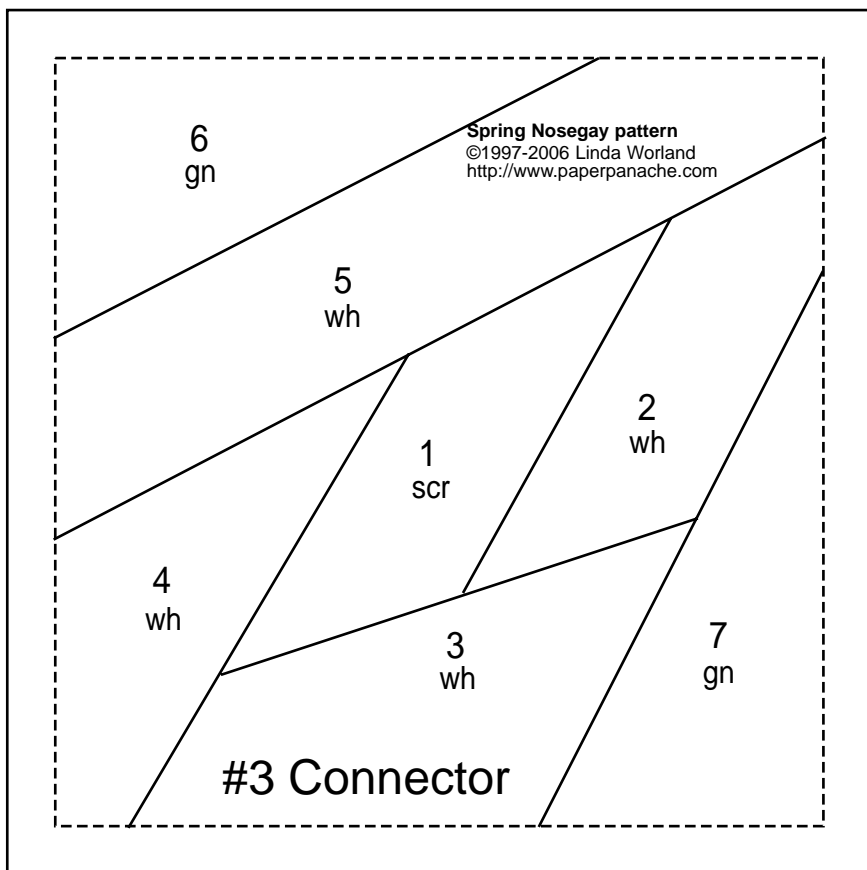


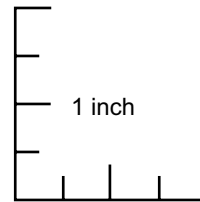
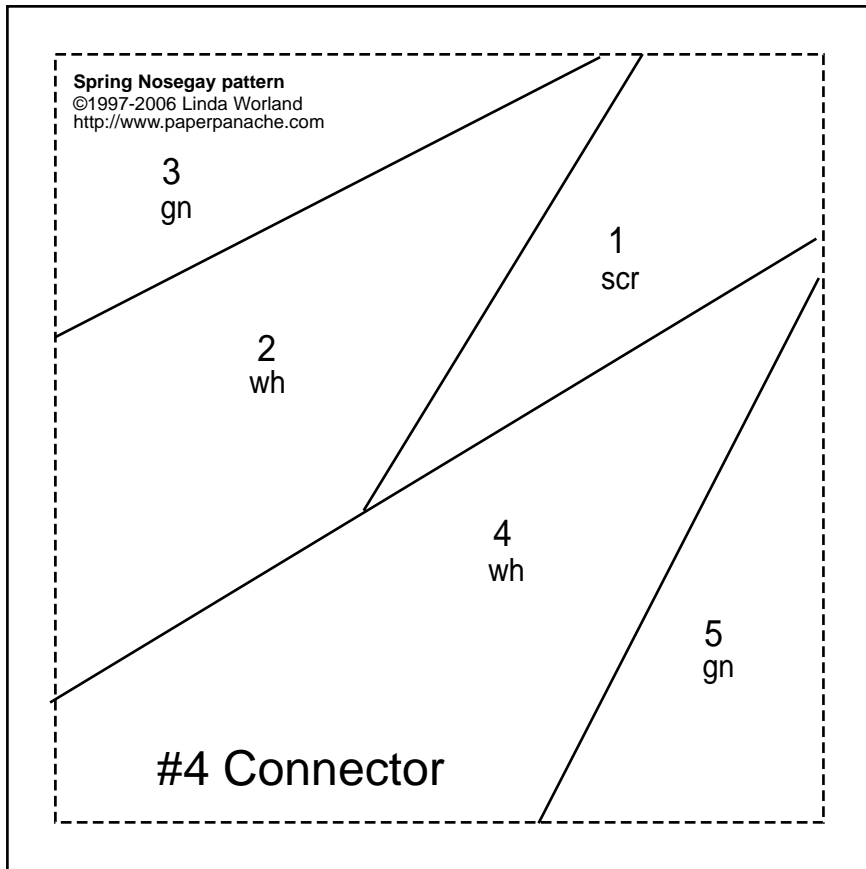
## Connector Pattern #3
